CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TEACHING STAFF

1. Teachers should adhere to a responsible pattern of conduct and demeanor expected of them by the community.
2. Teachers should maintain active membership of professional organization and strive to improve education and profession through them.
3. Teachers should perform their duties in the form of teaching, tutorial, practical, seminar, research work and co-operate and assist in carrying out functions relating to the educational responsibilities of the college and university, including supervision, invigilation and evaluation.
4. Teachers should participate in extension, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, inclusive of community service.
5. Teachers should respect the right and dignity of the students and deal with impartiality regardless of religion, caste, political, economic, social and physical characteristics.
6. Teachers should recognize the individual differences of students and not behave in an unkind manner towards any of them for any reason.
7. Teachers should be a friend, philosopher and guide to their students.
8. Teachers should refrain from provoking students against other students, colleagues or administration.
9. Teachers should treat other members of the profession in the same manner as they themselves wish to be treated and speak respectfully of other teachers.
10. Teachers should refrain from lodging unsubstantiated allegations against colleagues to higher authorities and refrain from allowing consideration of caste creed, religion, race or sex in their professional endeavor.
11. Teachers should discharge their professional responsibilities according to the existing rule and adhere to procedures and methods consistent with their profession.
12. Teachers should refrain from undertaking any other employment and commitment which are likely to interfere with their professional responsibilities.
13. Teacher should co-operate in the formulation of policies of the institution and other responsibilities conferred to them.

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14. Teachers should refrain from availing themselves of leave except on unavoidable grounds.
15. Teachers should treat the non-teaching staff as colleagues and equal partners.
16. Teachers should work to improve education in the community and be aware of social problems and work towards progress of the society.
17. Teachers should refrain from taking part in any activity which tend to promote feeling of hatred or enmity among communities, religion or linguistic groups and work for National Integration.
18. Teachers should dress befitting that of a Teacher educator and should refrain from dressing casually while on duty.
